He has a deep passion to know Christ Jesus and to see others know Him intimately, to the point that the love and joy of Christ become infectious.

In addition to his pastoral ministry, Spitler spends time coaching youth sports, promoting adoption, and volunteering with Mission to North America (MNA), the local missions arm of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA). Spitler serves as an Assessor at the PCA Assessment Center, promotes church planting within Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, and coaches potential church planters. He also served last year on the Board of Directors for the NC division of America World Adoption Association.

Spitler was born in Montgomery, Alabama and graduated from the University of Alabama – Birmingham after also attending Auburn University. He earned his Master of Divinity from Birmingham Theological Seminary and his Doctor of Ministry from Covenant Theological Seminary in St. Louis, Missouri. He and his wife Sandy have seven children, ranging in age from 8 – 33. Their two youngest children are adopted from China.

SouthLake Church is a member of the Catawba Valley Presbytery in the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA).
